Natural Farming focuses on living soil and Indigenous Micro-Organisms (IMO's). IMO's are the missing link in "organic" farming. They convert organic material into the inorganic minerals and nutrients the plants can utilize.

What You Will Learn

You will learn a completely sustainable system of farming that requires no off-island inputs and provides abundant and nutritious food. Learn how to:

- collect and cultivate Indigenous Micro-Organisms
- make Oriental Herbal Nutrient (OHN), Lactic Acid Bacteria (LAB), Fermented Fruit Juice (FFJ), Fermented Plant Juice (FPJ), Fish Amino Acid (FAA), Water-Soluble Calcium (WCA), and Water-Soluble Calcium Phosphate
- These ingredients enhance plant growth and you will learn how to apply these inputs in synchronization with the nutritive life cycle of plants.

In the Livestock workshop you will learn how to raise chickens, pigs and cows sustainably without foul odors. The Natural Farming system uses IMO's and produces animal feeds on site.

Mr. Cho has devoted his life to developing, perfecting, and sharing these techniques with farmers in 32 different countries including Korea.
